



Bristol Central High School (Bristol, CT)

Problem:

22-acre athletic field site consisted of three baseball fields and football field inside stone-dust running track. Desired reconfiguration included include two baseball fields, one softball field, three soccer fields and one football/soccer field inside 400-meter synthetic track, and one practice football field.

Solution:

Site was stripped, with topsoil screened and placed by the general contractor. Championship Turf Services then laser graded approximately 11 acres of playing surface. After seed/sod bed preparation, Championship Turf Services Brillion seeded approximately six acres with 90 percent improved Kentucky Bluegrass and 10 percent improved perennial ryegrass; we also sodded the 99,000 s.f football/soccer field and 140,000 s.f baseball/soccer field. Remainder of disturbed lawn and slope areas were seeded and hydraulically mulched.
